



## Highway 131 Pavement Resurfacing Marin County – Tiburon

Beginning late June through early September 2009, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a pavement resurfacing project on Highway 131 in Tiburon that will impact night traffic.

Construction activities on SR 131 will be from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday. The project limits are 0.2 miles west of US 101 and SR 131 separation to Mar West Street in Tiburon. Motorists are advised to use caution while traveling through the construction area.

All work is weather dependent so dates may change if inclement weather conditions occur. Dry pavement is needed to perform these construction activities.

The project includes placing rubberized asphalt over a four-mile stretch of highway, restriping, and shoulder backing. Noise levels will be high during these times because of the type of construction equipment used to perform this operation. Caltrans will make every effort to keep noise to a minimum and implement dust control measures.

We truly appreciate your understanding and patience during this construction and will diligently work to minimize resident and motorist delays and inconvenience. This temporary inconvenience will result in a smoother and safer ride for motorists.
