| 5. Second and subsequent plan submittal | 50% of original fee charged. |

| c. Tenant Improvements under 10 heads | \$94.00 |
| d. NFPA 13d | \$188.00 per system up to 40 heads + \$3.00 per head for each head over 40. |

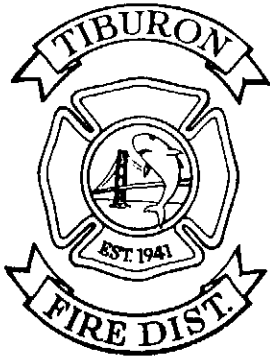

2. Automatic Extinguishing Systems	
a. Hood and Duct up to 6 nozzles	\$94.00
b. Hood and Duct over 6 nozzles	\$141.00
c. Spray booths and other systems	\$94.00 per hour or portion of an hour One hour minimum.
3. Fire Alarm Systems	
a. Sprinkler system monitor only	\$94.00
b. Buildings under 6000 square feet	\$235.00
c. Buildings over 6000 square feet	\$141.00 + \$94.00 per hour for inspection and testing, one hour minimum.
4. Misc. systems	
a. Private fire hydrants	\$235.00
b. Dry and wet standpipes	\$235.00
c. All other systems	\$94.00 per hour or portion of an hour One hour minimum.
5. Additional plan reviews and inspections	
a. Second and subsequent plan submittal	50% of original fee charged.
b. Additional Inspections above two	\$94.00 per hour or portion of an hour One hour minimum.

1. Tents and temporary structures	
a. Under 1500 square feet	\$94.00
b. 1500 to 6000 square feet	\$188.00
c. Over 6000 square feet	\$141.00 + \$94.00 per hour for inspection, one hour minimum.
d. Other Fire Code Permits	\$94.00 per hour or portion of an hour One hour minimum.
